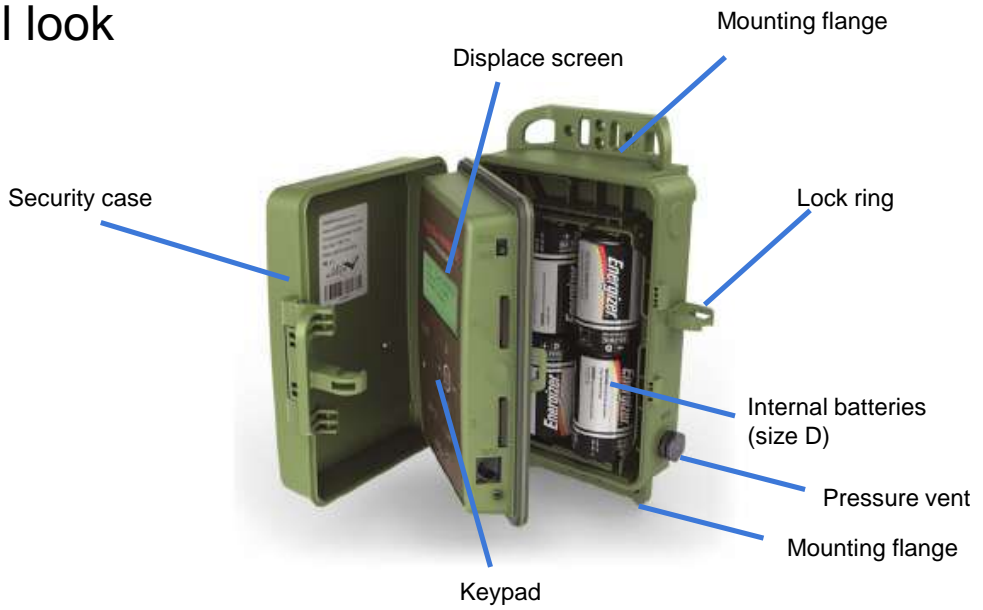

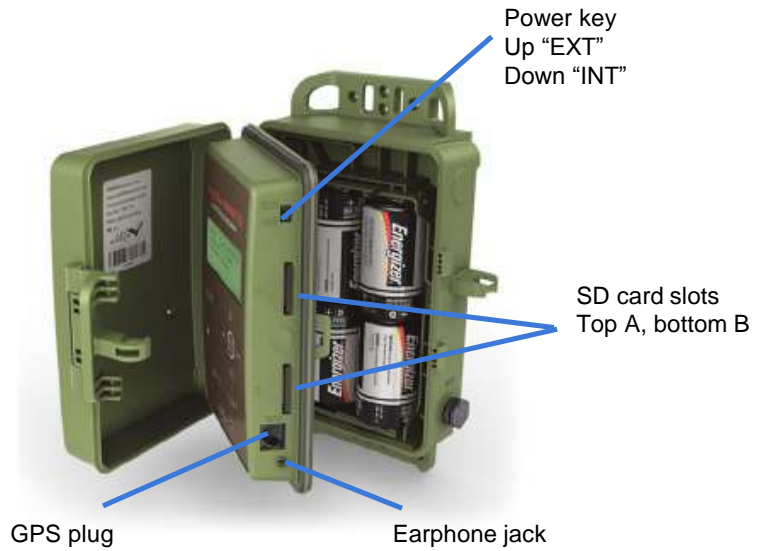
Two models: SM4BAT FS (full spectrum) and SM4BAT ZC (zero-crossing)

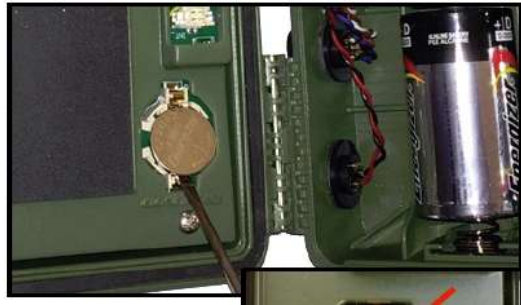

## Clock battery

1. CR2032, last for 3 years
2. Remove the battery
3. Install the battery



## Use SM4 BAT FS

1. Set power key to "INT"
2. Connect external power cable to the battery (6v 12 ah)
3. Connect the power cable to the recorder
4. Set power key to "EXT"
5. What is the firmware version

## Update firmware

## Update firmware

1. Insert memory cards into slots
2. Main manu
3. Utilities
4. Update firmware

Note: insert of the card with latest firmware into the slot A

5. Turn off the recorder
6. Turn on the recorder



## Check status

1. Press the check status
2. Check the information on the screen

Please setup the date and time following the Greenwich Mean Time of your country/area (<https://greenwichmeantime.com/time-zone/asia/>) to second(note, the time of Hobo data logger should be the same)

## Instant recording

1. Make sure no recording session on or standby
2. If any, press "Schedule Stop"
3. Press both "up" and "down" keys at the same time

## Quick start recording

1. Main manu
2. Quick Start

Name	Definition of schedule
Record Sunset→Rise	Based on your location, date and sunrise/sunset settings, records continuously from sunset until sunrise.
Record Always	Records continuously 24 hours a day.

3. Schedule Start: "prepare recording until...."

4. Schedule Stop

Note: sunset/rise recording require location setup

# Schedule recording

## Schedule recordings

1. Manual setup on SM4
2. Import preset schedule(by SM4 configurator) (recommend)

## Import Schedule

1. Main manu
2. Schedule
3. Import schedule +set from the memory card in **the slot A**
4. Schedule Start: "prepare recording until...."
5. Schedule Stop
